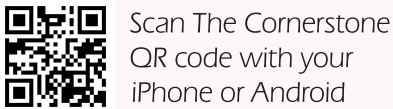

Not Shaken, But Stirred! by Donna Bramlett



There is a saying among engineers: Earthquakes don't kill people; buildings do. With that in mind, they have made great strides in designing and building structures and even tunnels that can withstand substantial earthquakes. There are some interesting parallels that make our theme – **WE WON'T BE SHAKEN** – even more significant, because trials don't destroy us but their effect on our structure can.

Here are a few things engineers are implementing:

- Build on a solid foundation
- Utilize a symmetrical design
- Limit ornamentation
- Include diaphragms and springs to absorb some of the sway
- Cross-bracing and flexibility
- Add a heavy weight on top as a shock absorber (mass damping)

So what does that have to do with The Cornerstone? Obviously, we cannot prevent the troubles that shake our world, but we have in a spiritual and business sense implemented some of these dynamics to preserve this ministry. For example, from the beginning The Cornerstone has been built on the solid foundation of Christ, our solid rock. We have grown upward, extending our signal far and wide even as we reach heavenward through worship and uncompromising truth. Also, we don't have a lot of fluff, excessive ornamentation that becomes a distraction. Add to that a great deal of grace to absorb the many nuances and differences in people's faith, offering truth without harsh judgment. Cross-bracing and flexibility is accomplished through the rich variety of people who contribute to The Cornerstone as programmers, volunteers, voices on the radio and behind the scenes, and listeners share our message with others.

Of course, the heavy weight on top is that weight of glory we all look forward to that keeps us grounded and focused. *"For this light and momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, as we look not to the things that are seen, but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal."* (2 Corinthians 4:17-18 ESV)
