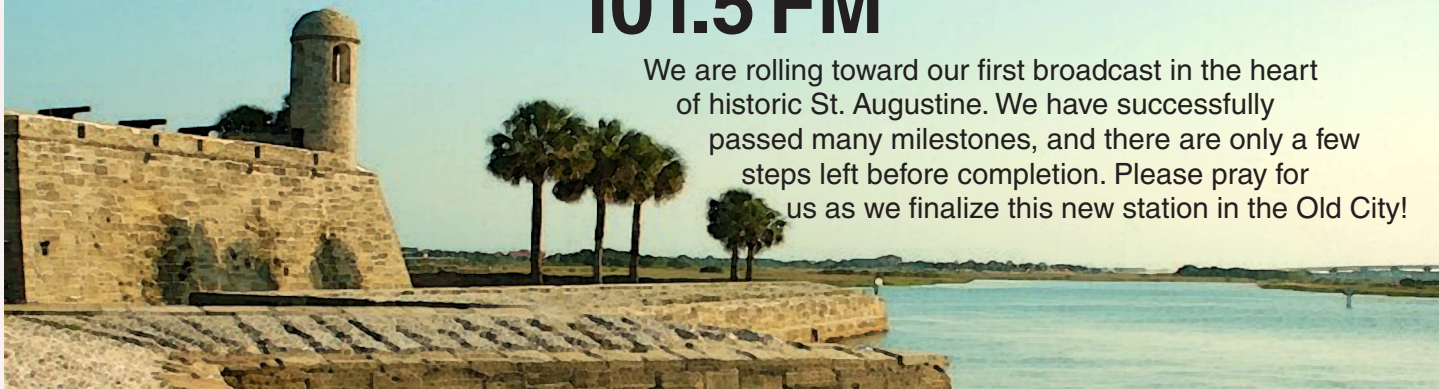


We're almost there!


