this, but some of the miraculous things I have witnessed in this ministry have come functional radio station they could only sell through the licensing side of it. We currently have nine licenses. Six of the licenses are obtain the license. We were given the first for the radio stations and three are for the license to send the audio to the transmitter sites. The reason I bring this up is that these were all a gift from God.

You can't just decide you want a radio station, sign up, buy equipment and broadcast. If you had lots of money you could where you wanted to broadcast). To start one from scratch is nearly impossible these days because most of the frequencies are taken. Our licenses were given free of charge because they are in the noncommercial band. But to acquire them took prayer, timing and expertise that not many have.

We are convinced it was the prayers of the saints that brought about our licenses along with the expertise of a few godly men. The timing comes into play because it is only every 8 to 10 years that the opportunity to file for a license is available. If frequencies are available one can only file when a filing window is opened by the FCC and that only happens every 8 to 10 years. The next is when multiple people file for the same frequency, which usually happens. It gets hung up in the bureaucracy for usually another 10 years.

Why am I telling you this? Well, as we all know, God works in mysterious ways.

The Lord placed in our laps a license to broadcast a 1000 watt FM station in Key West, Florida. As I said earlier if you have the technical licensing lots of money you could buy a license. In our side of Cornerstone case another company went through all the prayer, expertise and timing to get the license but was unable to follow through to put it on the air. Since it is only a license and not a it for the cost of the engineering incurred to chance to buy it and couldn't pass it up. Once it is built, it could be sold for market value.

It is our intention to have it up and running by November of this year. We will broadcast from our studios in Port Orange. The format will be similar to WMFJ 1450. We plan to fund it from the businesses and listeners in go buy a radio station (if one was for sale the Key West broadcast area. It will have a separate budget and revenue stream.

> If you know anyone who would like to have a presence in Key West for their business or ministry please let me know. The mission is the same, to preach the Gospel to the world as a witness and to disciple the saved. We look forward to seeing how the Lord will work in the lives of those in the Keys. What a joy to see the work of the Lord grow in such a time of uncertainty!
